Snow King Master Plan Phase 2

Background

Snow King Mountain Resort (SKMR) has been collectively working with the U.S. Forest Service (USFS) and the Town of Jackson (TOJ) for the last several years to amend their Master Plan and Base Area Master Plan Amendment.

An acceptance of a USFS Master Plan in 2014 was coupled with public presentations and open houses through 2014 and 2015 to gather public input and suggestions. Comments and suggestions from the public were implemented into a 2017 USFS Master Plan update.

SKMR entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the TOJ in July of 2017 to establish the terms and responsibilities of the Town and Snow King Resort Master Association (SKRMA) as it relates to the update of the Snow King Planned Resort District Master Plan.

The TOJ agreed to be a cooperating entity and support the USFS commencing its review procedure for the Snow King Forest Service Master Plan.

Engagement Process

The TOJ contracted with

a facilitator to facilitate a 16-person stakeholder group appointed by the TOJ to discuss the proposals and weigh community benefit and public comment. Stakeholders consisted of a variety of user, community and conservation groups who were invited to share their knowledge and history of the ski hill with fellow participants.

Stakeholders met during seven (7) stakeholder meetings to discuss proposed infrastructure improvements such as the gondola, summit multi-purpose building, boundary expansion, access road and more with community public comment in mind.

Members of the community at large were invited to actively participate in the process by attending three open house engagement meetings, submitting public comment to the stakeholder group, and attending a stakeholder meeting to offer public comment.

In May 2018, the Snow King Stakeholder process wrapped up with the group presenting their four (4) scenarios to the Jackson Town Council at a Town Workshop.

Looking to the Future

SKMR continues to work closely and collaboratively with the TOJ and USFS to move the US Forest Service Master Plan and Base Area Master Plan Amendment forward.
